## INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS the Protocol 2 on Unlimited Fifth Freedom Traffic Rights Between Any ASEAN Cities was opened for signature at Brunei Darussalam on 12 November 2010,

AND WHEREAS the Protocol 2 on Unlimited Fifth Freedom Traffic Rights Between Any ASEAN Cities has been signed on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Singapore on 12 November 2010,

AND WHEREAS Paragraph 2 of Article 4 of the said protocol provides that it shall be subject to ratification or acceptance by the Contracting Parties who have ratified or accepted the ASEAN Multilateral Agreement on the Full Liberalisation of Passenger Air Services,

NOW THEREFORE I, George Yong-Boon Yeo, Minister for Foreign Affairs, declare that the Government of the Republic of Singapore, having considered the said protocol, ratifies the same and undertakes faithfully to perform and carry out the stipulations therein contained.
