INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS the Protocol 6 on Unlimited Fifth Freedom Traffic Rights between ASEAN Capital Cities was adopted at Manila, the Philippines, on 6 November 2008,

AND WHEREAS the said protocol has been signed on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Singapore on 20 May 2009,

AND WHEREAS Paragraph 2 of Article 5 of the said protocol provides that it shall be subject to ratification or acceptance by the Contracting Parties who have ratified or accepted the ASEAN Multilateral Agreement on Air Services,

NOW THEREFORE I, George Yong-Boon Yeo, Minister for Foreign Affairs declare that the Government of the Republic of Singapore having considered the abovementioned protocol ratifies the same and undertakes faithfully to perform and carry out the stipulations therein contained.
