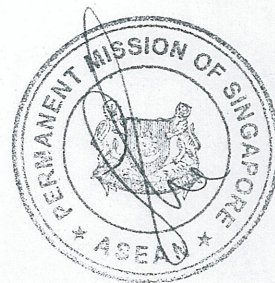

## INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS the *Protocol to Amend the ASEAN Comprehensive Investment Agreement* ("the Protocol") has been signed on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Singapore at Nay Pyi Taw, Myanmar on the Twenty-Sixth Day of August, in the Year Two Thousand and Fourteen;

AND WHEREAS Article 6(1) of the aforesaid Protocol provides that the Protocol shall enter into force after all Member States have notified the completion of their internal procedures for the entry into force of the Protocol to, or, where necessary, deposited instruments of ratification or acceptance with, the Secretary-General of ASEAN;

NOW THEREFORE I, K Shanmugam, Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Singapore, declare that the Government of the Republic of Singapore, having considered the aforesaid Agreement, ratifies the same and undertakes faithfully to perform and carry out the stipulations therein contained.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have signed this instrument of ratification in Singapore on this Ninth Day of January, in the Year Two Thousand and Fifteen.
