INSTRUMENT OF ACCEPTANCE

the Protocol 6 on Railways Border and Interchange Stations

WHEREAS the Protocol 6 on Railways Border and Interchange Stations under the ASEAN Framework Agreement on Facilitation of Goods in Transit was signed by the duly authorized representative of the Government of the Lao People's Democratic Republic, at Phnom Penh, Cambodia, on 16 December 2011,

WHEREAS Article 8 (3) of the Protocol stipulates that the Protocol is subject to ratification or acceptance by the Contracting Parties; and Article 8 (4) provides that the Protocol shall enter into force upon the deposit of Instruments of Ratification or Acceptance by all Contracting Parties with the Secretary-General of ASEAN,
