INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS the Protocol 2 on Unlimited Third, Fourth and Fifth Freedom Traffic Rights Among All Points with International Airports in ASEAN was signed at Manila, the Republic of the Philippines, on 20 May 2009, by the duly authorized Representatives of the Governments of Brunei Darussalam, the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Republic of Indonesia, the Lao People's Democratic Republic, Malaysia, the Union of Myanmar, the Republic of the Philippines, the Republic of Singapore, the Kingdom of Thailand and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam;


WHEREAS Article 6 (3) of the Protocol stipulates that this Protocol shall enter into force on the date of the deposit of the third (3rd) Instrument of Ratification or Acceptance with the Secretary-General of ASEAN, and shall become effective only among the Contracting Parties that have ratified or accepted it;

WHEREAS Article 6 (2) of the Protocol stipulates that the Instruments of Ratification or Acceptance shall be deposited with the Depository who shall promptly inform each Contracting Party of such deposit; and

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND, having considered the aforesaid Protocol, hereby confirms and ratifies the same and undertakes to faithfully perform and carry out all the stipulations contained therein.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Instrument of Ratification is signed and sealed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Thailand.

DONE at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Bangkok, this 13th Day of *October* in the Year Two thousand Five hundred and Fifty-two of the Buddhist Era, corresponding to the Year Two thousand and Nine of the Christian Era.
