INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

AGREEMENT ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE ASEAN CENTRE FOR ENERGY

WHEREAS the Agreement on the Establishment of the ASEAN Centre for Energy was signed in Manila on 22 May 1998 by the duly authorized Representatives of the Governments of Brunei Darussalam, the Republic of Indonesia, the Lao People's Democratic Republic, Malaysia, the Union of Myanmar, the Republic of the Philippines, the Republic of Singapore, the Kingdom of Thailand and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam;

WHEREAS Article 12(1) provides that the Agreement shall enter into force on the date of the deposit of the ninth instrument of ratification with the Secretary-General of ASEAN;

NOW THEREFORE, the Government of Brunei Darussalam having considered the said Agreement, hereby formally ratifies the same and undertakes faithfully to perform and carry out the stipulations contained therein.
