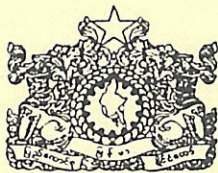

**INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION**

WHEREAS the Protocol to Implement the Sixth Package of Commitments on Air Transport Services under the ASEAN Framework Arrangement on Services was signed in Ha Noi, Viet Nam on 10 December 2009.

AND WHEREAS Paragraph 5 of the Protocol provided that it shall enter into force on the sixtieth day after the deposit of the sixth instrument of ratification or acceptance from ASEAN Member States with the Secretary-General of ASEAN;
