INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS the Protocol to Implement the Eighth Package of Commitments on Air Transport Services under the ASEAN Framework Agreement on Services ("Protocol") has been signed on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Singapore at Pakse, Lao PDR on 20 December 2013;

AND WHEREAS Paragraph 4 of the Protocol provides that the Protocol shall enter into force on the sixtieth day after the deposit of the seventh Instrument of Ratification or Acceptance from ASEAN Member States with the Secretary-General of ASEAN;

NOW THEREFORE I, K Shanmugam, Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Singapore, declare that the Government of the Republic of Singapore, having considered the abovementioned Protocol, ratifies the same and undertakes faithfully to perform and carry out the stipulations therein contained.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have signed this instrument of ratification in Singapore on this Fourth Day of May, in the Year Two Thousand and Fifteen.
