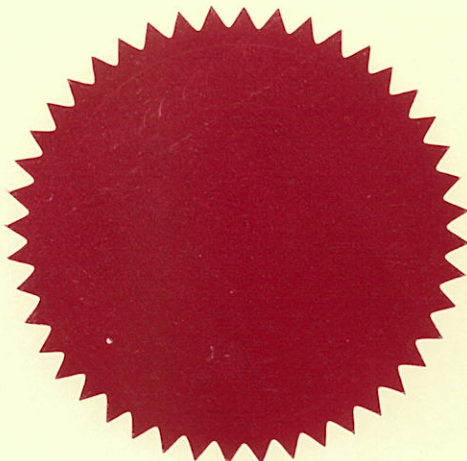
WHEREAS Article 8(3) of the aforesaid Protocol stipulates that this Protocol is subject to ratification or acceptance by the Contracting Parties;
