INSTRUMENT OF NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS the Third Protocol to Amend the ASEAN Comprehensive Investment Agreement (hereinafter referred to as “the Third Protocol”) was signed in Ha Noi, Viet Nam on 20 December 2017.

AND WHEREAS Paragraph 1 of Article 2 of the Third Protocol provides that the Third Protocol shall enter into force after all Member States have notified the completion of their respective internal procedures for the entry into force of this Third Protocol to, or, where necessary, deposited instruments of ratification or acceptance with, the Secretary-General of ASEAN.
