INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS the Protocol to implement the Eighth Package of Commitments on Financial Services under the ASEAN Framework Agreement on Services (hereinafter referred to as “the Protocol”) was signed on 5 April 2019;

AND WHEREAS paragraph 6, 7 and 8 of this Protocol shall enter into force on the date of deposit with the Depository of written notification from all ten ASEAN Member States within one hundred and eighty (180) days after the date of its signing (on 5 April 2019).

NOW THEREFORE, the Government of Malaysia, having considered the Protocol, ratifies the same and undertakes to perform and carry out faithfully all stipulations therein contained;

IN WITNESS THEREOF, this Instrument of Ratification is signed and sealed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs, Malaysia.
