INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS, the First Protocol to Amend the ASEAN Trade in Goods Agreement was signed in Hanoi on 22 January 2019;

AND WHEREAS Article 2 (2) of the Protocol provides that the Protocol shall enter into force on the thirtieth day after the date on which all Member States have notified the Secretary-General of ASEAN of the completion of their internal procedures. Such notification should not take more than one hundred and eighty (180) days after the date of signing of this Protocol;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Aung San Suu Kyi, Union Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar, declare that the Government of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar, having considered the said Protocol ratifies the same and undertakes faithfully to perform and carry out all the stipulations therein contained;
