INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

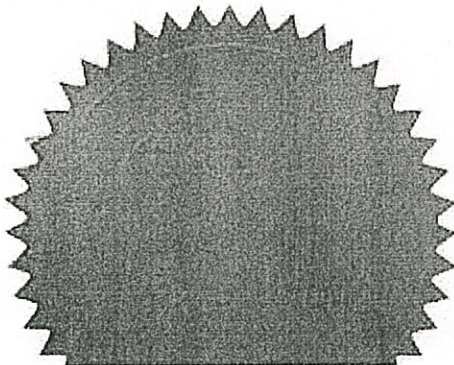
WHEREAS the ASEAN Multilateral Agreement on the Full Liberalisation of Freight Services (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement") was signed on behalf of the Government of Malaysia on 20 May 2009 in Manila, Philippines;

AND WHEREAS Article 20, paragraph 2 of the Agreement provides that it is subject to ratification or acceptance by the Contracting Parties and the Instrument of Ratification or Acceptance shall be deposited with the Secretary-General of ASEAN who shall promptly inform each Contracting Party of such deposit;

NOW THEREFORE, the Government of Malaysia, having considered the abovementioned Agreement, ratifies the same and undertakes faithfully to perform and carry out the stipulations therein contained.
