INSTRUMENT OF NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS the Fourth Protocol to Amend the ASEAN Comprehensive Investment Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "the Fourth Protocol") was signed in Ha Noi, Viet Nam on 15 July 2020.

AND WHEREAS Paragraph 1 of Article 5 of the Fourth Protocol provides that the Fourth Protocol shall enter into force after all Member States have notified the completion of their respective internal procedures for the entry into force of this Fourth Protocol to, or, where necessary, deposited instruments of ratification or acceptance with, the Secretary-General of ASEAN.

NOW THEREFORE, the Government of Malaysia, having considered the Fourth Protocol, hereby notifies the other Parties of Malaysia's completion of its internal procedures necessary for entry into force of this Fourth Protocol.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, this Instrument of Notification is signed and sealed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs, Malaysia.
