The Permanent Mission has the further honour to recall that in accordance with Article 37, paragraph 1 of the ATISA, the ATISA shall enter into force one hundred and eighty (180) days after the signing of the ATISA.

The Permanent Mission has the further honour to request that His Excellency acknowledge receipt of this notification by the Government of the Republic of Singapore in writing.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Singapore to ASEAN avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the ASEAN Secretariat the assurances of its highest consideration.
