INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS Protocol to Amend the ASEAN Mutual Recognition Arrangement on Tourism Professionals (ASEAN MRA-TP), was signed on 24 June 2022.

AND WHEREAS Article 3 Paragraph 1 of the said Protocol stipulates that the Protocol shall enter into force, after all Member States have deposited their instrument of ratification, acceptance of approval with the Secretary-General of ASEAN upon the completion of their internal procedures.
