INSTRUMENT OF NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS the Protocol to Amend the ASEAN Agreement on the Movement of Natural Persons (hereinafter referred to as "the Protocol") was signed on 7 March 2024 in Manila, the Philippines;

AND WHEREAS paragraph 2 of Article 2 of the Protocol provides that each Member State shall, upon completion of its internal procedures for entry into force of this Protocol notify the Secretary-General of ASEAN in writing.

AND WHEREAS paragraph 3 of Article 2 of the Protocol stipulates that where a Member State is unable to notify the completion of its internal procedures within 90 days of the date of signature, the rights and obligations of that Member State under this Protocol shall commence on the date on which that Member State notifies the completion of its internal procedures.

NOW THEREFORE, the Government of Malaysia, having considered the Protocol, hereby notifies other Member States of Malaysia's completion of its internal procedures necessary for entry into force of the Protocol.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, this Instrument of Notification is signed and sealed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia.
