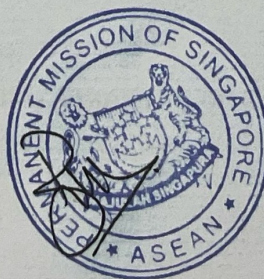

INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS the *Protocol 5 on Own Stopover Rights between Points within the Territory of any other ASEAN Member State* ("the Protocol") to the *ASEAN Multilateral Agreement on the Full Liberalisation of Passenger Air Services between the Governments of the Member States of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations* was signed on 21 February 2025 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia;

AND WHEREAS the said Protocol has been signed on behalf of the Government of Singapore on 21 February 2025;

AND WHEREAS Article 4(2) of the Protocol provides that the Protocol is subject to ratification or acceptance by the Contracting Parties and that the Instruments of Ratification or Acceptance shall be deposited with the Secretary-General of ASEAN;

AND WHEREAS Article 4(3) of the Protocol provides that the Protocol shall enter into force on the date of the deposit of the third Instrument of Ratification or Acceptance to the Secretary-General of ASEAN and shall become effective only among the Contracting Parties that have ratified or accepted it, and that a Contracting Party depositing its Instrument of Ratification or Acceptance after the date of entry into force of this Protocol shall enter into force for that Contracting Party on the date of its deposit of Instrument of Ratification Acceptance;

NOW THEREFORE I, Dr Vivian Balakrishnan, Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Singapore, declare that the Government of the Republic of Singapore, having considered the abovementioned Protocol, ratifies the same and undertakes faithfully to perform and carry out the stipulations therein contained.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have signed this Instrument of Ratification on this nineteenth day of May, in the Year Two Thousand and Twenty-Five.
