INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS the Protocol 5 is to implement the continuity to the co-terminal right that has been granted under Protocol 4 on Co-Terminal Rights between Points within the Territory of any other ASEAN Member State (hereinafter referred to as "the Protocol") was signed on 18 November 2018 in Bangkok, Thailand;

AND WHEREAS the Protocol was signed on behalf of the Government of Malaysia on the 21 February 2025 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia;

AND WHEREAS Article 4 of the Protocol provides that it shall enter into force on the date of the deposit of the third Instrument of Ratification or Acceptance with the Secretary-General of ASEAN and shall become effective only among the Contracting Parties that have ratified or accepted it;

NOW THEREFORE the Government of Malaysia, having considered the Protocol, ratifies the same and undertakes to perform and carry out faithfully all stipulations therein contained;

IN WITNESS THEREOF, this Instrument of Ratification is signed and sealed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs, Malaysia.
