INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS the Protocol 5 on Own Stopover Rights between Points within the Territory of any other ASEAN Member State was signed in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia on 21 February 2025 by the duly authorised representative of the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand; and

WHEREAS Article 4, paragraph 2, stipulates that this Protocol is subject to ratification or acceptance by the Contracting Parties. The Instruments of Ratification or Acceptance shall be deposited with the Secretary-General of ASEAN who shall promptly inform each Contracting Party of such deposit;

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND, having considered the aforesaid Protocol, hereby confirms and ratifies the same and undertakes faithfully to perform and carry out all the stipulations therein contained.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Instrument of Ratification is signed and sealed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Thailand.

DONE at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Bangkok, this 24th day of November in the Year Two thousand Five hundred and Sixty-eight of the Buddhist Era, corresponding to the Year Two thousand and Twenty-five of the Christian Era.
