**INSTRUMENT OF ACCESSION
TO THE ASEAN MULTILATERAL AGREEMENT ON THE FULL LIBERALISATION
OF PASSENGER AIR SERVICES AND ITS SUBSEQUENT PROTOCOLS**

WHEREAS the ASEAN Multilateral Agreement on the Full Liberalisation of Passenger Air Services, signed on 12 November 2010, in Bandar Seri Begawan, Brunei Darussalam and its subsequent Protocols, as follows:

- (i) Protocol 1 on Unlimited Third and Fourth Freedom Traffic Rights between any ASEAN Cities, signed on 12 November 2010, in Bandar Seri Begawan, Brunei Darussalam;
- (ii) Protocol 2 on Unlimited Fifth Freedom Traffic Rights between any ASEAN Cities, signed on 12 November 2010, in Bandar Seri Begawan, Brunei Darussalam;
- (iii) Protocol 3 on Domestic Code-Share Rights between Points within the Territory of any other ASEAN Member States, signed on 13 October 2017, in Singapore; and
- (iv) Protocol 4 on Co-Terminal Rights between Points within the Territory of any other ASEAN Member State, signed on 09 November 2018, in Bangkok, Thailand,

WHEREAS the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste, on 14 March 2025, expressed its readiness to accede to the ASEAN Multilateral Agreement on the Full Liberalisation of Passenger Air Services and its subsequent Protocols 1, 2, 3, and 4,

NOW THEREFORE I, Bendito dos Santos Freitas, Minister for Foreign Affairs and Cooperation, declare that the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste, having considered the above-mentioned ASEAN Multilateral Agreement on the Full Liberalisation of Passenger Air Services, and its subsequent Protocols 1, 2, 3, and 4 accedes to the same and undertakes faithfully to perform and carry out the stipulations therein contained.
