INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

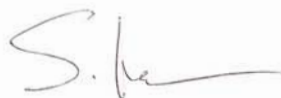
WHEREAS the Cebu Protocol to Amend the Charter of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations was agreed on 8 May 2026 during the 48th ASEAN Summit in Cebu and

WHEREAS Article 3 stipulates that this Cebu Protocol shall be subject to ratification by all ASEAN Member States in accordance with their respective internal procedures and shall enter into force on the thirtieth day following the date of deposit of the last instrument of ratification with the Secretary-General of ASEAN;

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND, having considered the aforesaid Protocol, hereby confirms and ratifies the same and undertakes to faithfully perform and carry out all the stipulations therein contained.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Instrument of Ratification is signed and sealed by the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Thailand.

DONE at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Bangkok, this 19th day of June in the Year Two thousand Five hundred and Sixty-nine of the Buddhist Era, corresponding to the Year Two thousand and Twenty-six of the Christian Era.
